

## Procedure 9.13 **Training Course Exceptions**

### ***“There are no exceptions”***

The experience of Imago Relationships International is that making exceptions to established guidelines usually leads to problems.

The most common problem is that the exception is granted to just one person, whereas many other deserve it, leading to feelings of unfairness and favoritism, which work against the spirit of a relational organization.

Many people come to us with good reasons why they should be granted something which currently lies outside our guidelines. Our response is to look into changing the policies to accommodate variations which make sense, and appear fair.

Requests for these changes to policy should be brought to the faculty advisory committee.

The faculty advisory committee will bring recommendations for policy changes to the faculty for approval.
